Plant Sizes

The size of plants is categorised by measurement across the leaf span from leaf-tip to leaf-tip, not including tendrils and pitchers. There are 5 size categories:

XS = between 2.5cm and 5cm
S = between 5cm and 8cm
M = between 8cm and 15cm
L = between 15cm and 30cm
XL = larger than 30cm
